What are the ISA Awards of Distinction?

The ISA Awards of Distinction (formerly the ISA International Awards) is the longest running ISA award program and is recognized as the highest honor bestowed by ISA. Recipients are chosen from nominations submitted by members and industry professionals, usually recognizing nominees for lifetime achievements or bodies of work. Entries are reviewed by the Awards Committee and a judging panel, and recipients are announced at the ISA Annual Conference.

What is the purpose of the Awards of Distinction?

ISA strives to recognize individuals who have faithfully contributed to the practice of arboriculture through education, best practices, publications, or science and research. A brief description of each award is available on the nomination form and online.

What are the benefits of receiving an Award of Distinction?

Recipients receive recognition at the opening ceremony of the ISA Annual International Conference, as well as extensive recognition in the tree care industry through press releases, the ISA website, and articles in Arborist News and other ISA publications. Award winners also receive extensive public exposure through national or international press releases and advertisement in their local hometown newspapers.

Honorary Life individuals are given complimentary membership for their lifetime – this membership is non-transferable.
- R. W. HARRIS AUTHOR'S CITATION**, granted to authors of outstanding publications for sustained excellence in the publication of timely information pertaining to the field of arboriculture.
- L.C. CHADWICK AWARD FOR ARBORICULTURAL RESEARCH**, granted to individuals to recognize research that has contributed valuable information to arboriculture.
- EXCEPTIONAL CONTRIBUTION TO PRACTICAL ARBORICULTURE**, granted to individuals to recognize service that has made a substantial contribution to practical arboriculture.
- EARLY-CAREER SCIENTIST AWARD**, granted to individuals who show exceptional promise, with high potential to become an internationally-recognized scientist.
- HONORARY MEMBERSHIP** recognizes individuals who are not members of ISA who have continued interest and outstanding service in promoting arboriculture. Honorary individuals are also given a complimentary 12-month ISA membership. Recipients will have made material contributions to the advancement of arboriculture through research, field practice, promotion, invention, or literature.
